We have a separate kindergarten program in the spring, with a registration form distributed through the schools. For the \$35 fee your child receives a quality soccer ball, a team shirt and is eligible to play in the fall & spring soccer seasons.

Registrations must be mailed by August 26th. Those mailed after that date will be accepted on a space available basis only.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are pleased to have your child participate in Northwest Kiwanis Youth Soccer. Teams are coached by adult volunteers. Games are officiated by UAHS & GHHS soccer players for the Bantam Leagues (1st - 4th grades) and by certified officials for Intermediate Leagues (5th & 6th grades). Our program stresses participation, sportsmanship, soccer skills and having fun in a team environment.

Although the game rules we observe prohibit the more physical forms of contact associated with soccer (e.g., slide tackling in the Bantam leagues), there is no way to totally avoid the possibility of an injury to a participating child. As a non-profit organization, the Northwest Kiwanis Club, its volunteers and officers cannot reasonably assume the financial responsibility for an injury that a youngster might sustain at a game or practice. We encourage you to observe a few obvious precautions. Your child should not participate if he/she is ill, has a full stomach, or is wearing ill-fitting shoes. Shin guards are recommended for the Bantam leagues AND REQUIRED for the older leagues. NO JEWELRY IS ALLOWED. Mouth guards are highly recommended for all age groups.

To permit your child to participate in our youth soccer program, you attest that:

"I hereby consent to my child's participation in the Northwest Kiwanis Soccer Program for Fall 2010 and Spring 2011. I agree to hold The Kiwanis Club of Northwest Columbus (OH) and all its officers, volunteers and agents in the program, and Kiwanis International (including its districts), and the Cities of Grandview Heights and Upper Arlington and their employees, harmless for any accidents or injuries to my child while participating in practices and/or games."
